**3:00 Old Testament Lesson**

Exodus 16:27-36

27 On the seventh day some of the people went out to gather, and they found none. <sup>28</sup>The LORD said to Moses, 'How long will you refuse to keep my commandments and instructions? <sup>29</sup>See! The LORD has given you the sabbath, therefore on the sixth day he gives you food for two days; each of you stay where you are; do not leave your place on the seventh day.' <sup>30</sup>So the people rested on the seventh day.

31 The house of Israel called it manna; it was like coriander seed, white, and the taste of it was like wafers made with honey. <sup>32</sup>Moses said, 'This is what the LORD has commanded: "Let an omer of it be kept throughout your generations, in order that they may see the food with which I fed you in the wilderness, when I brought you out of the land of Egypt." '

<sup>33</sup>And Moses said to Aaron, 'Take a jar, and put an omer of manna in it, and place it before the LORD, to be kept throughout your generations.' <sup>34</sup>As the LORD commanded Moses, so Aaron placed it before the covenant, for safe-keeping. <sup>35</sup>The Israelites ate manna for forty years, until they came to a habitable land; they ate manna, until they came to the border of the land of Canaan. <sup>36</sup>An omer is a tenth of an ephah.
